📝 Abstract Submission Guidelines

Step 1 – Submit the Abstract First

All participants must submit an abstract before preparing the full presentation/poster.
Submit your abstracts and final posters to: riconvns2026@gmail.com

The abstract should:

- Be text-based and concise.
- Clearly state the title, objective/background, methodology or case description, results/findings, and conclusion/learning points, as applicable to the category.
- Include ONE relevant figure/image in the ABSTRACT only. *The final poster may include multiple figures/images as appropriate.*
- The figure should be of good quality and directly support the submitted work.
- *Avoid submitting the complete poster or presentation at the abstract stage.*

After Abstract Acceptance

Step 2 – Submit the Full Presentation / Poster

Only accepted abstracts will proceed to the full presentation/poster stage.

Category	Final Submission Format
Oral Paper – Original Research	Slides – maximum 10 slides
Digital Poster – Original Research / Pictorial Review	Slides – maximum 10 slides
Case Report Poster	Single-slide digital poster

Important!!

Abstract → Review & Selection → Acceptance → Full Presentation/Poster Submission

Please do not prepare or submit the full poster/presentation unless the abstract has been accepted.

Guidelines for Abstract & Poster Submission

Abstract Categories

1. Oral Paper Presentation – Original Research

- Only original research will be considered.
- Selected abstracts will be invited for oral presentation.
- The final oral presentation should be prepared in slide format, with a maximum of 10 slides.

2. Digital Poster Presentation – Original Research / Pictorial Review

- Original research or educational/pictorial reviews are eligible.
- The final poster should be prepared in slide format, with a maximum of 10 slides.

3. Case Report Poster – Interesting / Educational Cases

- Submit interesting, unusual, or educational radiology cases with clear imaging findings and learning points.
- The final poster should be prepared as a single-slide digital poster, following the reference format.

Theme: Advancing Radiology Across All Subspecialties, Modalities and Frontiers

Submissions are encouraged across all radiology subspecialties, imaging modalities, interventional radiology, artificial intelligence, emerging technologies, and other frontiers in radiology.
